Insoluble:- "Insoluble" generally means that a substance does not dissolve in water.

Example:- Sand, fats and metals etc.

Metals:- Materials which have certain properties like lustre, malleability, ductility and are sonorous, good conductors of heat and electricity are called metals.

Soluble:- Soluble substances are those substance which disappear or dissolve when mixed with water.

Example:- Salt and sugar.
