What were the two major cities under the control of the Chahamanas?

Ans! - Delhi and Ajmer were the two cities under control of the Chahamanas.

Q. 5

How did Rashtrakutas become powerful?

Ans! It was during the seventh century that the kings acknowledged the big landlords as their subordinates or samantas. The samantas were expected to bring gifts and provide military support to their kings. In due course they gained power and wealth. They declared themselves to be maha-samantas, mahamandaleshvar and so on. Rashtrakutas were one of them who were initially the subordinates of the Chalukyas in Deccan. In the mid-eighth century, Dantidurga, a Rashtrakuta chief, performed a ritual hiranya-garbhā and overthrew the Chalukya overlord.
