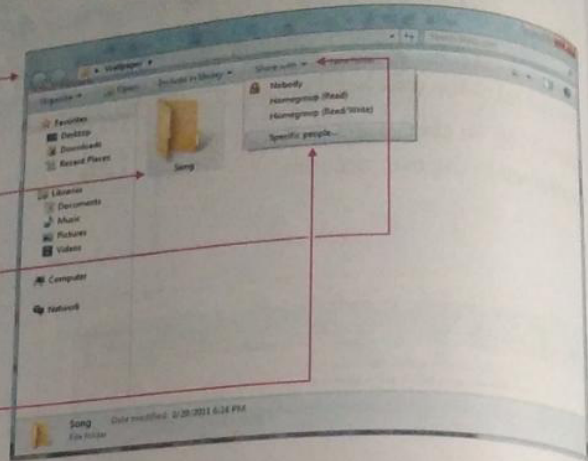

Sharing Information

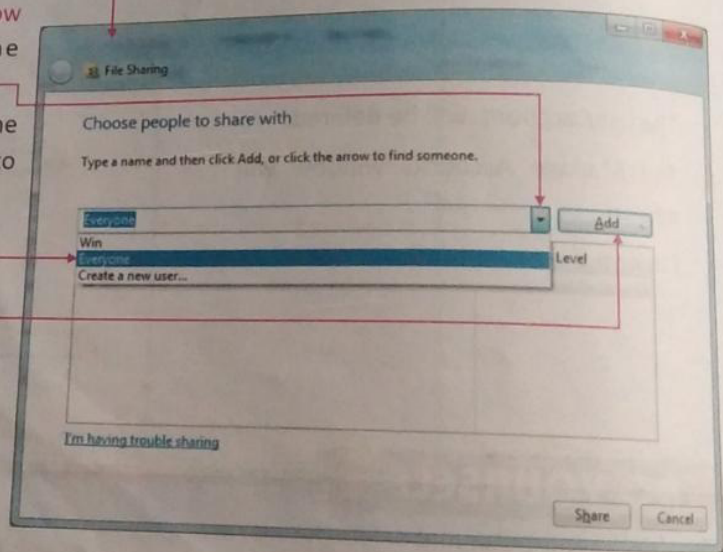
You can share information contained on your computer with other people on the network.

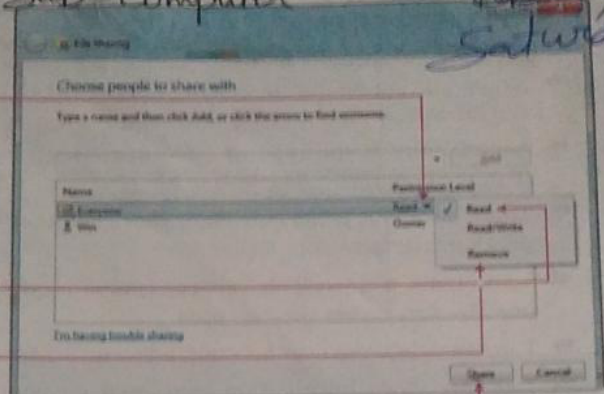

Read/Write: User can read and make changes in the document.

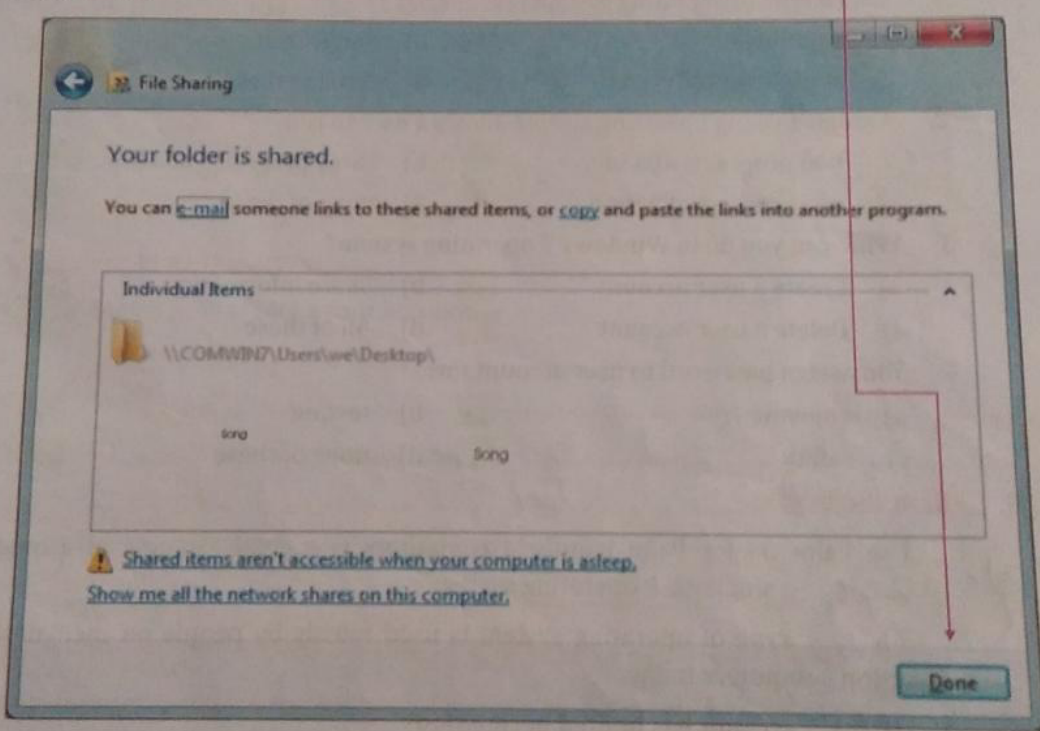


10. Click on **Share**.

11. Click on **Done**.



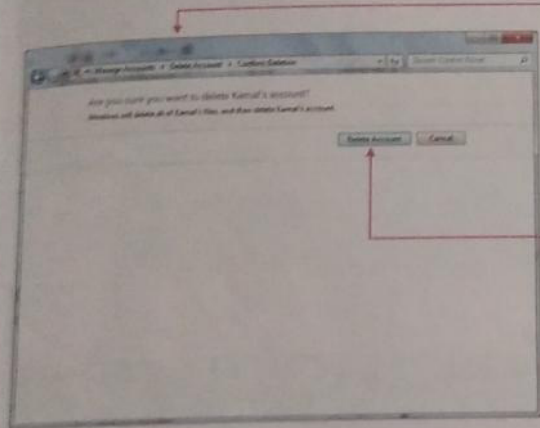
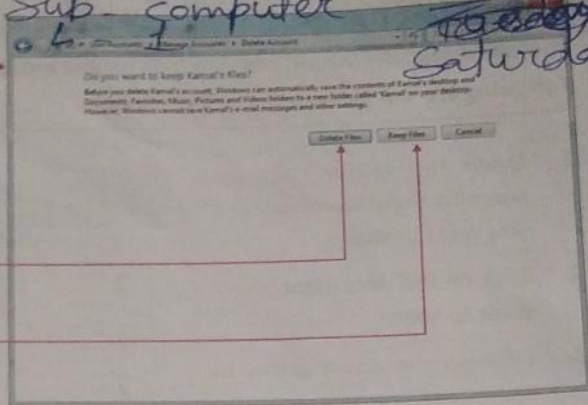

Keep Files: To keep users personal files contained in the user account.



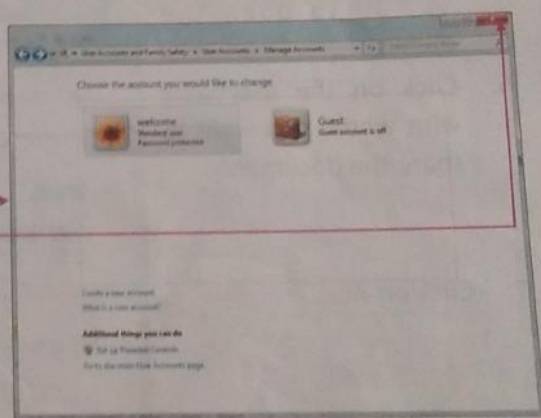
The Confirm Deletion window will appear.
