Use of Articles ('A', 'An' and 'The')
'A' and 'An' are called Indefinite Articles. We use 'A' before a word starting with a consonant or having a consonant sound. We use 'An' before a word starting with a vowel or having a vowel sound.

Examples: Rohit is **a** good boy.
Rohit is eating **an** apple.

'The' is called a Definite Article. We use 'The' before the names of unique things such as newspapers, holy books, sunrises and mountain peaks.

Examples: **The** sun rises in the east.
He was reading **the** Gita.
