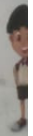

attached to the wings of birds which help them to fly. The body of a bird is light in weight because it is made of hollow bones. These help it to fly easily for a long time. The tail of a bird helps into change direction while flying.



Birds and various parts of its body

**How does a bird fly ?**

When a bird has to fly, it lifts itself up in the air by flapping its wings. This movement of moving upward and forward is called **up stroke**.



**Do you know?**

The peregrine falcon is the fastest bird and can reach up to a speed of 300 km/hour.

When a bird lands, it spreads out the wings and it glides down smoothly without much flapping.

This downward flapping of wings is called **down stroke**.

**Do all Birds Fly ?**

Birds such as ostrich, penguin, emu, kiwi and rhea can not fly. They have big bodies and small wings. The ostrich, emu and rhea have powerful legs to allow them to walk and run. Penguins are able to walk almost upright.

Many kinds of birds live around us. The body of a bird is covered with feathers.

Birds such as parrots, owls and crows live on trees. Some birds like ostriches, emus and lapwings live on land.
