Sentences are divided into different kinds according to their functions. Here are the main kinds of sentences :

Assertive Sentence

A sentence that makes a statement is called an assertive sentence. This sentence may be an **affirmative** sentence or a **negative** sentence. This sentence has a **full stop** (.) at the end.

Examples of Affirmative Sentences

- My brother is an engineer.
- We are the students of the Akash Public School.
- Robin and Alester have come to meet us.
- She went there to learn classical music.
- Ravina's new bicycle is very beautiful.
- Our house is at the bank of a river.



Examples of Negative Sentences

- I have **no** money to spend on luxuries.
- I **did not** wake up early yesterday morning.
- Smriti **does not** sleep during a lecture.
- Rohit is **not** a good boy.
- We **do not** eat meat.
- An elephant has **no** horns.

Interrogative Sentence

A sentence which asks question is called an interrogative sentence. An interrogative sentence can begin with is, am, are, has, have, will, can, should, etc or with 'wh' word like what, when, where, etc.

This sentence has an **interrogation mark (?)** at its end.

- Can you lift this weight easily?
- Why do you wear a jacket in summer?
- Who will give the answer of my question?
- Is he your younger brother?
- When is your parents' wedding anniversary?



Imperative Sentence

A sentence which is used to give a command or to make a request is called an imperative sentence. In imperative sentence, the subject 'you' is not given. This sentence is marked by a **full stop (.)** at the end.

- Come and sit here with me.
- Switch off the fan and go to your room.
- Let me do my work now.
- Stop smoking now.
- Please hold my books for a moment.



Exclamatory Sentence

An exclamatory sentence expresses some sudden and strong feeling. It is marked by an **exclamation mark (!)** at the end.

- What a beautiful palace this is !
- How horrible the scene was !
- Hurrah ! I have won the gold medal.
- Alas ! His grandmother has died.
