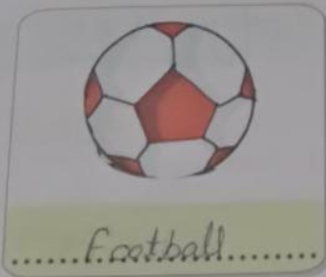

### Use of Articles ('A', 'An' and 'The')

'A' and 'An' are called Indefinite Articles. We use 'A' before a word starting with a consonant or having a consonant sound. We use 'An' before a word starting with a vowel or having a vowel sound.

Examples: Rohit is a good boy.  
Rohit is eating an apple.

'The' is called a Definite Article. We use 'The' before the names of unique things such as newspapers, holy books, sunrises and mountain peaks.

Examples: The sun rises in the east.  
He was reading the Gita.

### WORD PROBLEMS ON SUBTRACTION



1. There are three parrots in a cage. Two of them flew away one by one. How many parrots are in the cage now?

$$3 - 2 = 1$$



2. 7 candles were burning on Sakshi's birthday cake. She blew off 4 of them. How many candles were left burning?

$$7 - 4 = 3$$



3. There were 6 horses in a field. 3 of them ran away. How many horses were left in the field?

$$6 - 3 = 3$$



4. There were 12 carrots. 3 of them were eaten by Rabbit. How many carrots were left?

$$12 - 3 = 9$$
