Peacocks feed on snakes, frogs, garden lizards, tender leaves and seeds. Their beaks are sharp and pointed.

Nesting Habits

Nesting or making nests is a common habit of birds. Since all birds lay eggs, they build nests to keep their eggs and young ones safe.

Birds use things like cotton, twigs, leaves, grass, wool and feathers to make their nests.



The ostrich is the only bird that has only two toes while all other birds have four toes.

They have claws at the end of each foot which enable them to walk on land.
The wings of a penguin are used as flippers when swimming.

Aquatic Birds

Ducks, geese and swans are all known as water fowl or aquatic birds, because they spend most of their time in lakes, ponds, rivers and the sea. They all have webbed feet and are the swimmers.
