Q⁷ What kind of Irrigation works were developed in Tamil region?

Ans: - During fifth or sixth Century the area of Tamil Nadu was opened up for large scale cultivation. For irrigation a variety of new methods were discovered. In many areas wells were dug. High tanks were constructed for rainwater storage.

Q⁸ What were the activities associated with Chola temples?

Ans: The Chola Temples were the nuclei of settlements growing around them which included centres of craft production. Temples were also endowed with land by rulers as well as by others. The produce of the land was used for the maintenance of the priests, garland makers, cooks, sweepers, musicians, dancers etc. who were associated with the temples were not simply the place of worship. They were also the hub of economic, social and cultural life as well.
